Parents briefed on activity and have given informed written consent to do activity	Spread of Covid-19	Players, coaches, parents, volunteers	Parents/carers have been advised of Covid-19 arrangements prior to consenting for their child to participate. LMFC Guidance, FA Summary Guidance documents have been sent to all parents and are also under the COVID-19 tab on our website where consent must be given.
Data Privacy Policy/ Notices updated to cover data handling of attendees to aid NHS Test and Trace	Spread of Covid-19	Parents, coaches, volunteers	Parents/carers have been advised that a register of attendance will be kept, with information sent to NHS test and trace should it become apparent they encountered someone showing symptoms of coronavirus while attending the football activity.

Covid-19 protocols shared with committee/volunteers/club members	Spread of Covid-19	Players, coaches, parents, volunteers	Detailed guidance on club protocols has been sent to club officials, coaches and parents. A copy of the guidance can be found on our website, in the coach and committee whatsapp group. Bullet point of protocols to be completed before/during/after all football activity can be found in coaches packs and on the garage wall.
Participants requested to do self-screen checks before travelling to session	Spread of Covid-19	Players, coaches, parents, volunteers	A copy of the self-screen checklist has been sent to all parents/carers and participants including coaches and volunteers. Must complete before attending any football activity.
Coaches informed to check that self-screen checks have been done	Spread of Covid-19	Players, coaches, parents, volunteers	The coaches have been told to make sure the participant (or parent/carer) has completed the self-screen checklist and that the answers negative. If the self-screen checklist has not been done the participant must leave the session immediately.
Playing area, e.g.: Clearly marked to support social distancing	Spread of Covid-19	Players, coaches, parents, volunteers	Pitches will be clearly marked prior to matches with yellow "Please keep a safe distance of 2 meters" tape. There is a red zone clearly marked on a map at the entry point which states only players, coaches or club officials allowed.
Register of those who attend sessions (to aid NHS Test and Trace if needed)	Spread of Covid-19	Players, coaches, parents, volunteers	Coaches have been informed they must always keep a register of attendance
Players items clearly labelled, no sharing	Spread of Covid-19	Players, coaches	Parents/carers requested to clearly label anything the children bring to football and to limit it to: water bottle, hand sanitiser, medication, sun cream, sun hat. No sharing
Equipment	Spread of Covid-19	Players, coaches	Equipment is to be limited to goals, cones and poles. They need to be cleaned after each use
Managing someone who becomes symptomatic	Spread of Covid-19	Players, coaches, parents, volunteers	Separate the player immediately from the wider group. Child should be taken home by parent/carer and follow Government guidance for symptoms of Covid-19. Other players/coaches present who have maintained social distancing do not need to follow any specific advice unless they develop symptoms. If a player becomes symptomatic during nay football activity it must be stopped immediately and not continued.

Arrival/departure to/from training	Spread of Covid19	Players, coaches, parents, volunteers	Everyone to enter at the bottom of the recreation ground (Tesco end) And to adhere to the one-way system around the pitches. Parents urged to arrive and leave promptly. Parents informed of one-way system.
Entry/Exit to training areas	Spread of Covid19	Players, coaches, volunteers	Only players, coaches and volunteers allowed in pitches or in red zone.  Clear signage showing where players, coaches and club officials are allowed.
Hygiene before/after training	Spread of Covid19	Players, coaches	Prior to walking to pitch via one-way system all players and coaches will sanitise their hands at the hand wash station. Parents have also been asked to send their child with individual hand sanitiser.
Spectating	Spread of Covid19	Parents, members of public	All parents with exception of Mini Matravers, U7 & U8 have been urged to leave. Those who stay have been told not to enter red zone and to be aware of members of the public using footpaths. Spectators have been told the bottom of the recreation ground nearest park is safest place to wait in order to maintain social distancing.
			During matches spectators are to be kept to a minimum and must not retrieve the ball if it goes out of play. Must always follow FA Respect Guidelines
Return to training & play	Spread of Covid 19	Players, coaches	In line with FA guidance maximum of 30 children Players and coaches to still maintain social distancing
PPE	Spread of Covid19	Players, coaches, volunteers	PPE will be required to be used for first aid support (Masks, Gloves)
Transportation of players to training and matches	Spread of Covid19	Players, parents, coaches, volunteers	All Parents will be responsible for transporting their child to and from training/matches.  Coaches and other parents are not permitted to transport other players unless they are in their support bubble.

Training, Times & Training areas	Spread of Covid19	Players, parents, coaches, volunteers, members of public	All Parents and players have been advised that they should NOT ATTEND training if they are showing symptoms of Covid 19 and follow Government guidance for self-isolation.  Training sessions start times to be staggered to reduce numbers of people on site.  Appropriate breaks between training sessions to allow enough time for players and parents to leave and socially distance.  Coaches to clean down all equipment used before and after training.  Number of players per session will need to be in line with Government and FA guidance.
Club House & Toilets	Spread of Cov19	Players, parents, coaches, volunteers	Club house and toilet facilities to remain closed. Parents and players have been informed of this.
